INVOLVEMENT  
ADOPTION STATEMENT**

In accordance with Regulation 24(4) and Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, a Notice is given that Adur District Council formally adopted its Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) on 14 December 2006.

The SCI is a formal statement of the District Council's policy that needs to be complied with when involving interested parties in preparing the Local Development Documents to be included in the Adur District Local Development Framework (LDF) and when consulting on planning applications.

An independent Inspector was appointed by the Government to examine the 'soundness' of the submitted SCI. The Inspector reported back to the District Council on 2 October 2006 setting out binding changes to be made to the submitted SCI.

Both the Inspectors report and the adopted SCI, along with the adoption statement, are available for inspection at the Civic Centre, Ham Road, Shoreham by Sea, West Sussex BN43 6PR. Copies are also available for inspection at all local libraries, Lancing Area Office, Southwick Area Office and Sompting Community Centre. In addition, the documents can be viewed and downloaded from the Adur District Council website [www.adur.gov.uk](http://www.adur.gov.uk), or sent to you by phoning 01273 263246.

Any person aggrieved by the SCI may make application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004. Any challenge pursuant to Section 113 must be made on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate power or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. An application under Section 113 must not be made later than the end of the period of six weeks starting from 14 December 2006.

Any person aggrieved by the SCI may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for Judicial Review of the decision to adopt the statement. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months from 14 December 2006.
