ORDER 2006**

The above Order made on 12th December 2006, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding a length of footpath, having a width of 2 metres, from Upper Brighton Road, Worthing, opposite Sompting Road, (grid reference 1506 0512), running in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 98 metres, to join Footpath no. 3134 at grid reference 1505 0522.

A copy of the Order and the Order Map may be seen free of charge at County Hall, Chichester and at Worthing Borough Council Offices, Town Hall, Chapel Road, Worthing from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and at Broadwater Library, Dominion Road, Broadwater, Worthing during opening hours. Copies of the Order and Map may be bought at County Hall at the price of £2.00.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to Legal Services, West Sussex County Council, County Hall, Chichester, West Sussex PO19 1RQ (please quote reference PG/FP3134) not later than 22nd February 2007, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made. Please note that any representations or objections will be held on a file that is available for public inspection. However, it is open to an individual to request that their personal details are omitted from that file.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, and if any so made are withdrawn, the West Sussex County Council instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn, will be sent with it.

NOTE:

The County Council is required to keep under continuous review the Definitive Maps and Statements of Public Rights of Way which were first prepared in 1952. It has come to the Council's notice that a section of the continuous public footpath leading from Upper Brighton Road to Lambleys Lane, Worthing is missing in error from the Definitive Map for the Worthing area. There is good evidence that this should be shown on the Definitive Map and so the above-mentioned definitive map modification order has therefore been made in order to rectify this omission. The Order does not affect the situation on the ground.
