

# Shoreham Airport



## Consultation on development proposals

Erinaceous, the new owners of Shoreham Airport, will be displaying proposals for the refurbishment of the listed Terminal Building and associated development between **3pm and 8pm on Thursday 1 February 2007** at Shoreham Airport, Premier House, Ground Floor Eastern Entrance, Cecil Pashley Way, Shoreham-by-Sea BN43 5FF.

The proposals feature:

- Restoration of the listed Terminal Building - improved public access with terminal functions and a restaurant on the ground floor and an aviation club and a function/conference suite above.
- Aviation square - two new three storey mixed-use buildings flanking the terminal building to provide a focal point at the heart of the airport.
- Flight centre - a new hangar and serviced office accommodation building.
- Airside operations building - a new fire station, air traffic control tower, and maintenance building.

Members of the public are invited to drop in to view the plans and discuss the proposals, representatives of Erinaceous and Shoreham Airport will be in attendance to answer queries and comments forms will be made available for feed back on the day.
