

**WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL
(WORTHING: A259 BRIGHTON ROAD)
(RESTRICTED ROAD
30 MPH SPEED LIMIT)
AND (CONSOLIDATION)
ORDER 2007**

NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council propose to make a permanent Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce a 30mph speed limit and reinstate restricted road status on a length of the A259 Brighton Road approximately 36 metres east of its junction with Ham Road to approximately 40 metres southwest of its junction with Western Road.

The opportunity is being taken to consolidate all existing provisions contained in Orders imposing a 30mph speed limit and restricted road status on a length of the A259 Brighton Road from its junction with High Street to approximately 36 metres east of its junction with Ham Road and from approximately 48 metres west of the junction with Western Road to the eastern kerb line of its junction with Western Road.

A copy of the draft Order, a plan showing the affected length of road and a statement of the County Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at West Sussex County Council, County Hall, West Street Chichester, during normal office hours, and at Worthing Public Library, Richmond Road Worthing during normal library opening hours. Library staff will NOT be in a position to answer questions on the proposal and all enquiries should be addressed to the undersigned, quoting Ref No ENV3/3416/HB

Objections to the proposal together with the grounds on which they are made, or any other comments, must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 23rd February 2007.
