

**WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL
(WORTHING: DURRINGTON
LANE (PART))
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE)
ORDER 2009**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 5 February 2009, West Sussex County Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from proceeding along a length of Durrington Lane in Worthing, from the entrance to Centenary House, northwards for a distance of 40 metres. Pedestrian access will be maintained.

The Order is necessary to enable sewer connections to be made beneath the carriageway.

The alternative route for southbound vehicles will be via Columbia Drive, Romany Road, Yeoman Road and Littlehampton Road (A2032), and visa versa for northbound vehicles.

The Order will become active on 9 February 2009 and it is expected that the work will last for approximately 4 weeks. Once made, the Order will remain in force for a maximum of 18 months, or until the proposed works are completed, whichever is earlier.
