

LICENSING ACT 2003
Premises Licence Variation
TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

We, Richard Haygarth and Anita Webber, do hereby give notice that on 17th February 2009 we served application on the Licensing Authority Worthing Borough Council, and the relevant authorities, for a variation of the premises licence on the premises known as:

Hill Barn Golf Club situated at Hill Barn Lane, Worthing, BN14 9QF

The application seeks to vary the licence to:

- 1) Extend the hours for the sale of alcohol to 08.00hrs - 00.00hrs every day.
- 2) Extend the time for the provision of regulated entertainment to 19.00hrs - 00.00hrs every day.
- 3) Authorise the sale of late night refreshment from 23.00hrs to 00.00hrs every day.
- 4) Remove the embedded restrictions converted over from the Justices' liquor licence.
- 5) Authorisation for the sale of alcohol, for consumption off the premises, from the pro-shop, adjacent to the currently licensed areas and highlighted on the attached plan of the clubhouse.

Any person who desires to make objection to the said grant should set out, in writing, a brief statement of the grounds of his/her objection and send to The Licensing Unit, Health & Housing Services, Worthing Borough Council, Portland House, Richmond Road, Worthing BN11 1HS. Representations must reach the Licensing Unit by no later than: **Friday 18th March 2009.**

The application may be viewed in full at the above offices between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm Monday to Thursday and 9.00am and 4.00pm Friday. Information as to the date of hearing to determine the application may be obtained from the Licensing Unit at Worthing Borough Council.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with an application and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for the offence is £5,000.
