

HIGHWAYS AGENCY**THE A27 TRUNK ROAD - CROSSBUSH
INTERCHANGE****TEMPORARY OVERNIGHT SPEED RESTRICTIONS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport intends to make an Order on the A27 Trunk Road, near Arundel in the County of West Sussex, under section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because works are proposed to be executed on the road.

The effect of the Order would be to impose overnight temporary mandatory speed restrictions on the following lengths of the A27:

- (a) a 50 mph speed restriction on the westbound carriageway between points 3100 metres east and 1600 metres east of Crossbush Interchange roundabout (A284);
- (b) a 40mph speed restriction on the westbound carriageway between points 1600 metres east and 150 metres east of Crossbush Interchange roundabout (A284); and
- (c) at certain stages of the work, a 10mph speed restriction would be imposed on a length of the westbound carriageway between a point 600 metres east of Crossbush Interchange roundabout (A284) and that roundabout while traffic is escorted through the works area by a convoy system.

These measures would be in the interests of road safety while contractors undertake resurfacing work.

It is expected that the work would take place over a 2 week period starting on or after Monday 30th March 2009 between 2000 and 0600 hours.

The Order would come into force on 28th March 2009 and have a maximum duration of eighteen months.

The temporary mandatory speed restrictions would be clearly indicated by traffic signs when they are in operation during the works periods.
