

**WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL  
(LANCING: PUBLIC FOOTPATH  
NO. 2048 (PART))  
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE)  
ORDER 2009**

NOTICE is hereby given that on the eighteenth day of March 2009, West Sussex County Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit any person from proceeding along a length of Public Footpath No. 2048, Lancing from its junction with the Brighton Road (GR20940473) northwards to the rear of the NCDL Kennels (GR20710481).

The Order is necessary to protect public safety whilst engineering works are undertaken by the Environment Agency at the Lancing Brook Site.

The alternative route is via Bridleway No. 2048/1 and the footways of A283 Old Shoreham Road and A259 Brighton Road.

The Order will come into effect on 23rd March 2009 and will last for 6 months or until the proposed works are completed. It is anticipated that the works will commence on or after 23rd March 2009 and will take 5 months to complete.
