Premises Licence Variation

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

We, Peter William Mott & Barry Christopher Wells trading as The Lounge Leisure Group served application on The Licensing Authority, Worthing Borough Council and the relevant authorities to vary the premises licence on the premises known as:

The Liquid Lounge situated at 31 Chatsworth Road, Worthing BN11 1LY

The application seeks to:

- Amend the conditions of the premises licence associated with the provision of adult entertainment in the bar area known as 'Le Chic' reducing and limiting the number of events utilising adult entertainment to a maximum of 12 per annum.
- To authorise minor structural alterations to that area.
- To authorise the use of the entrance opening directly from the street into 'Le Chic' for public entry from the normal opening time of the club, 19.00hrs, until 02.00hrs of the following morning.
- To authorise the provision of late night refreshment for consumption on the premises within the bar area known as 'Le Chic' and from a mobile trailer situated in the enclosed designated smoking area adjacent to the main entrance to the club.

No changes to the normal hours of opening are proposed by this application. Any person who desires to make objection to the said grant should set out, in writing, a brief statement of the grounds of his/her objection and send to The Licensing Unit, Health & Housing Services, Worthing Borough Council, Portland House, Richmond Road, Worthing, BN11 1HS. Representations must reach the Licensing Unit no later than: **15th April 2009**. The application may be viewed, in full, at the above offices between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm Monday to Friday. Information as to the date of hearing to determine the application may be obtained from the Licensing Unit at Worthing Borough Council.
