

**WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL
(WORTHING: UNION PLACE)
(EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC REGULATION)
ORDER 2009**

NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council propose to make an experimental Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to permit vehicles to proceed only in a westbound direction in Union Place, Worthing over the length of road 16 metres from its junction with Chapel Road. Pedal cycles will not be affected by this restriction as a cycle lane permitting westbound travel will be installed.

A copy of the experimental Order, which will come into operation on 3 April 2009 and a statement of the County Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order for an experimental period may be inspected at County Hall, Chichester, during normal office hours, and at the Worthing Public Library, Richmond Road, Worthing during normal library opening hours.

Library staff will NOT be in a position to answer questions on the proposal and all enquiries should be addressed to the undersigned, quoting ref no. TROT/42/MM

Alternatively these documents are available to view on the Traffic Regulation Order pages of the West Sussex County Council website. This includes a response form for any objections or comments.

The County Council will consider whether the provisions of this experimental Order should be made permanent. Any objections or comments regarding the provisions of the experimental Order and/or the proposal to make those provisions permanent, together with the grounds on which they are made must be received by 9 October 2009.

(MINOR ORME ROAD AND PARK
AVENUE) ORDER 2009**

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 24th day of March 2009 West Sussex County Council made a permanent Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, ("the Act"), the effect of which will be to amend the Worthing (Parking Places and Traffic Regulation) (Consolidation) Order 2007 to remove restrictions which extend beyond the highway boundary in Orme Road and Park Road.

The restrictions in Orme Road are being amended following the stopping up of an area of highway at Brooklands Trading Estate.

The restrictions in Park Road extend beyond the highway boundary and onto hospital ground at the Greenacres site.

A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 9th April 2009, together with its associated plan showing the affected length of road, may be inspected at County Hall, Chichester, during normal office hours and at the Public Library, Richmond Road, Worthing during normal library opening hours.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from 9th April 2009 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
