THE A27 TRUNK ROAD – DEVILS DYKE
INTERCHANGE
TEMPORARY OVERNIGHT CLOSURE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport intends to make an Order on the A27 Trunk Road, in the City of Brighton and Hove, under section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because works are proposed to be executed on the road.

The effect of the Order would be to authorise the overnight closure of the eastbound carriageway of the A27 between the “off” and “on” slip roads at Devils Dyke Interchange (A2038). This would be in the interests of road safety to enable contractors to undertake signing and bridge maintenance work.

It is expected that the work would last for approximately three nights starting on or after Tuesday 14th April 2009 between 2000 and 0500 hours (maximum period).

The Order would come into force on 11th April 2009 and have a maximum duration of eighteen months.

During the closure outlined above, traffic affected would be diverted via the “off” slip road and rejoin the eastbound carriageway of the A27 via the “on” slip road at Devils Dyke Interchange (A2038).

The carriageway closure and diversion route would be clearly indicated by traffic signs throughout the works periods.
