

**WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL  
(WORTHING: TITNORE LANE (PART))  
(TEMPORARY ONE-WAY TRAFFIC)  
ORDER 2009**

NOTICE is hereby given that not less than seven days from the date of this notice, West Sussex County Council intend to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to require all vehicles in TITNORE LANE, from the roundabout junction with A259 Goring Street/Littlehampton Road and A2032 Littlehampton Road, northwards to its junction with Titnore Way to travel in a northerly direction only.

The alternative route for southbound traffic will be via Titnore Way, Romany Road, Yeoman Road and A2032 Littlehampton Road.

Pedestrian access to properties situated on or adjacent to the affected lengths of road will be maintained.

The Order is necessary to protect public safety whilst a new junction and access is constructed to the new St Barnabas Hospice.

The Order will come into operation on 17 April 2009 and will continue for 18 months or until the proposed works are completed, whichever is earlier. It is anticipated that the work will start on or after the 17 April 2009 and will take 8 weeks to complete.

Alexander Terrace, Ambrose Place, Ann Street, Ashdown Road, Bedford Row, Brighton Road, Byron Road, Chandos Road, Chatsworth Road, Graham Road, Gratwicke Road, Heene Road, Lennox Road, Liverpool Gardens, Liverpool Road, Liverpool Terrace, Marine Parade, Marine Place, Milton Road, New Parade, New Street, Newland Road, Orme Road, Park Road, Portland Road, Prospect Place, Richmond Road, Rowlands Road, Selden Road, Shelley Road, Southey Road, Station Road, Steyne Gardens, Surrey Street, Sussex Road, Thorn Road, Warwick Road, West Buildings, West Street, Westbrooke, Wordsworth Road and York Road.
