

# **NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER**

## **HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

### **WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (PATCHING) PUBLIC PATH (No 2263)**

#### **DIVERSION ORDER 2005**

On 27 January 2006, West Sussex County Council confirmed the above- named Order under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert part of Public Footpath No 2263 in the Parish of Patching as shown on the Order Map commencing at its junction with Bridleway No 2175 at the northern end of The Street (Grid Reference 0887 0685) extending generally north-north-eastwards for approximately 128 metres (Grid Reference 0889 0698) and substituting for that path a new length of public footpath commencing at the southern end of the length of path to be stopped up (Grid Reference 0887 0685) extending slightly to the east of the existing route to be stopped up and on a field edge with a minimum width of 4 metres in a generally north-north-easterly direction for approximately 72 metres (Grid Reference 0889 0692) turning generally northwards for approximately 62 metres to rejoin the existing path (Grid Reference 0889 0698).

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be seen free of charge at the office of the Legal Services Unit, County Hall, Chichester, West Sussex PO19 1RQ and at the office of Arun District Council, Arun Civic Centre, Maltravers Road, Littlehampton BN17 5LF on Mondays to Fridays during normal office hours. A copy of the Order and map may be purchased from the Legal Services Unit at the price of £2.

The Order comes into force on 17 February 2006, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 9 February 2006, make application to the High Court.
