

**WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL  
(LITTLEHAMPTON, LYMINSTER AND  
POLING: VARIOUS ROADS)  
(30MPH SPEED LIMIT)  
(AND SPEED LIMIT CONSOLIDATION)  
ORDER 2005**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 21st February 2006 West Sussex County Council made a permanent Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), the effect of which will be to impose a 30mph speed limit on a short length of Clay Lane and the entire length of Crossbush Lane, in the Parishes of Lyminster and Poling.

A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 27th February 2006, together with a plan showing the affected lengths of roads, may be inspected at County Hall, Chichester during normal office hours.

Any person who wishes to challenge the validity of the Order, or of any provisions contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from 27th February 2006 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
