

# **COAST PROTECTION ACT 1949 PROPOSED MONITORING OF TIDAL FLOW AROUND A SHIPWRECK ON THE OWERS BANK**

NOTICE is hereby given that the University of Southampton has applied to the Secretary of State for the Department of the Environment, Farming and Rural Affairs under Section 34 of the Coast Protection Act 1949, as amended by Section 36 of the Merchant Shipping Act 1988, for consent to monitor tidal flow around a shipwreck on the Owers Bank, Sussex.

Plans showing the position of the works may be inspected at the Chichester District Council, East Pallant House, East Pallant, Chichester PO19 1TY.
