

AUDIT OF ACCOUNTS

NOTICE OF PUBLIC RIGHTS



Each year the Sussex Police Authority's accounts are audited and any person interested has the opportunity to inspect and make copies of the accounts and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts relating to them. For the year ending 31 March 2006, these documents will be available at Sussex Police Headquarters, Lewes, East Sussex BN7 2DZ (telephone: 01273 404008) between 9.00am and 4.30pm on weekdays between Monday, 12 June and Friday, 7 July 2006.

Local government electors and their representatives also have:

- (1) The opportunity to question the Auditor, about the accounts. The District Auditor or his representative will be at Sussex Police Headquarters, Lewes, for this purpose on Tuesday, 11 July 2006 at 2.00pm to 5.00pm, and, after that date, will be available at the Audit Commission's Office, 16 South Park, Sevenoaks, Kent TN13 1AN (telephone: 01732 591350) until the audit has been completed.
- (2) The right to attend before the District Auditor and make objections to the accounts or any items in them. Written notice of an objection must first be given to the District Auditor and a copy sent to the Clerk to the Police Authority at the address given below.

The audit is being carried out by the Auditor, Mr N Ward, the Audit Commission, 16 South Park, Sevenoaks, Kent TN13 1AN and will be conducted under the provisions of the Audit Commission Act 1998 and the Accounts and Audit Regulations 2003.
