

**WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL
(LITTLEHAMPTON: FERRY FOOTBRIDGE)
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2006**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 17th May 2006, West Sussex County Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit any person from proceeding along the entire length of Ferry Footbridge, Littlehampton.

The Order is necessary to ensure the safety of highway users whilst the bridge remains in the open position and to enable repairs to be carried out to the bridge.

The alternative route for south-west bound traffic will be via River Road, Bridge Road (B2187), Bognor Road (A259) and Ferry Road and vice versa for northbound traffic.

A free taxi service will be provided every 20 minutes between 0630 and 2300 hours.

It is expected that the work will last for approximately 8 weeks starting on or after 19th May 2006.
